
BUTTON STARFISH



PaperScissorsPaints & Brushes (optional)Buttons or other small items for texture

- If using paint, line your work area with some old newspapers/something to catch the paint.
- **2** Draw a starfish shape on the plate and have your child cut along the outline!
- **3** Give the kid/s a brush and have them paint their starfish. Use markers/crayons/colored pencils if skipping the paint step.
- While waiting for your starfish to dry, scan the QR code below (by opening your camera app on your phone) to enjoy a starfish story read-along!


